This will give them an opportunity to become acquainted with their teacher and the new building. We will send out information in August and further details regarding this.

For parents of children in ECS, we will be calling you sometime before the end of June to schedule a small orientation visit prior to the start of the school year. This will be in late August. Students in Kindergarten will also have a staggered start to begin the school year. Your child will start on either September 4 or September 5.
