## Meet and Greet

A reminder that our Meet and Greet is scheduled for today Thursday, August 30 from 4:00 to 6:00 pm. You will have the opportunity to drop in and meet your child's teacher or teachers. Bring a device and if possible download the ACTIONBOUND APP prior to coming. It will guide the students as they do a scavenger hunt so they can add some pictures. They can also do it with a pencil and a handout. A cold treat will be provided when kids complete their tasks.

## <u>First Day – September 4</u>

On the first day of school we would like all students to enter the building VIA the MAIN SCHOOL DOOR. Students will proceed directly to their classroom and wait in their teacher's room for the start of school. Teacher names have been posted on the doors. Once you bring your child to the classroom it is strongly recommended that you wish them well and let them get on with their day once the teachers are ready to begin.

Students who are accessing Before School Care with SIGIS would enter the school at the EAST DOOR of the school near the visitor parking lot. Children will wait in the SIGIS room and then be brought to their classrooms near the start of instruction.

### **Robust Device**

We have had some parents ask us about our recommendations for a Robust Device for your child in grade 4-7. Although we won't recommend specific models or kind of devices we would encourage you to purchase a device that features the following:

-Wireless networking capability (the district provides wireless access in all buildings for students)

-A microphone

-An external keyboard for entering text

-An audio output for earbuds or headphones

-A minimum of 6 hours of use from one battery charge

-A full-functioning, recent Chrome web-browser that will allow access to Google Apps for Education tools and documents.

-A sturdy carrying case that will protect the device

-An integrated camera that takes both still photos and video

-The ability to run Flash software

Chromebooks, iPads, tablets, laptops of various types would have all or nearly all the features listed above.

#### **Parking and Unloading of Students**

It is paramount for student and staff safety that all visitors to the school drop off and pick up students in the correct areas of our site. The site plan for loading and unloading of passengers has been carefully designed to route traffic safely. All we need is the cooperation of visitors to the school to adhere to the plan.

#### STAFF PARKING

The Staff at Sister Alphonse Academy will park directly in front of the school along the North Side of the school. Staff should enter the staff parking lot via the northeast entrance. Visitors to the school MUST NOT ENTER the staff parking area.

#### **BUS LANE - LOADING AND UNLOADING OF STUDENTS**


Busses will enter the parking lot via the northwest bus lane. The BUS LANE is reserved for busses between the hours of 8:00 am and 9:00 am and 2:30 pm and 3:30 pm. The bus lane is one way only. Students will board and disembark busses along the sidewalk adjacent to the bus lane.

#### STUDENT DROP OFF

A passenger drop-off lane has been created along the north sidewalk in front of the school. This lane is only for dropping off of students. PARKING IS NOT PERMITTED in the drop off zone.

### VISITOR PARKING

A visitor parking lot is found immediately east of the school. Visitors should enter and exit the visitor parking lot via the northeast entrance.
