



#### **Report Cards and Interviews**

Please check your child's backpack as those children in grade 1 - 6 were sent home with a Term 1 report card to share with you. Once you have taken a minute to look it over spend some time with your child to share their accomplishments and discuss a goal for next term. Parent/Teacher Interview dates are Tuesday, Nov. 20/18 from 5:00 - 8:00 pm and Wednesday, Nov. 21/18 from 3:30 - 6:30 pm. In checking the online Interview Booking system we have noticed that nearly all of our parents have booked interviews, thank you for doing this! If you have not yet done this use the <u>School Interviews Link</u> to book an appointment. Once the link is open you should be able to go directly in and book your interview(s). If asked enter ACCESS CODE - sstra. Interview appointments for students in grade 1-7 will be 15 minutes long. ECS Student Led appointments will be 30 minutes. In Junior High parents may book interviews with individual subject teachers. Call our school office at 780-809-2996 if you are encountering any difficulties.

#### Term 1 Field Trip/Dynamic Option Fee Payments

# SAA School Council News

The **next meeting of School Council is on Wednesday, January 16 @6:30 pm**. Full minutes of our meetings are posted the month after they are approved on our <u>school website</u>. Some highlights of our November meeting. We welcomed our Trustee Liaison Mrs. Serena Shaw. School administration presented the school <u>2018/19 Education Plan</u>. The plan is built upon the 21st Century learning Framework that has been developed by the school and also lists priorities around our Faith goals. We are excited by the work that has been done and the priorities and goals that have been set. In January our Council will begin to build our School Council plan that will support our schools Education Plan. Our Council has decided to contact the Alberta School Council Association about a workshop that provides parent groups with information about the creation of a Fundraising Society. We hope to arrange for this workshop sometime in late January or February. At our meeting we decided to move forward with some initiatives and hope that we can count on your support.

- We are looking for parents who would volunteer to be a Class Representative at School Council. The role of the the Representative would be to attend Council meetings and provide a parent perspective (input-suggestions) for council at the grade level of the class they represent. If you are interested in serving as a Class Rep please contact either Mr. Lamer or Mrs. Kleparchuk and plan on attending our next meeting on Jan. 16.
- 2. We are looking for parents who would like to volunteer to be part of our Partners in Prayer Group at Sister Alphonse Academy. These parents would gather once a month to pray for the intentions submitted by students and staff throughout the month. A prayer format is provided by the Church and it usually requires about a 45 minute prayer gathering per month. If you are interested in serving as part of a Partners in Prayer Group please contact either Mr. Lamer or Mrs. Kleparchuk before the end of November.
- 3. We are looking for somebody to serve as a Volunteer Coordinator. This person's main responsibility would be to contact parents who have submitted their names to provide help/support events and/or activities throughout the school year.
