We require all parents to complete the online registration process and submit all information by Monday,

May 28. This must be completed to ensure that your child(ren) is/are officially registered for the 2019/20 school year. Your prompt attention to this task is appreciated. If you are registering a new sibling to our school and have already turned in a hard copy registration package you do not need to complete an online registration for that child.
