- If you are unable to attend, please contact Darryl ASAP. A makeup assignment will be given, or a makeup date will be assigned.
- This year we will only meet on Sundays for the session however the formation process also includes community formation. This means, candidates and catechumen are invited to attend the other events listed in the schedule, and announced by Darryl.
- In fairness to the process, if you miss more than 5 sessions, we will assess your status. It may be that in this case you be invited to continue to process the following year.
- Please be sure to mark your calendars with all the sessions and events listed.

The sponsor...

- Must be a practicing Catholic who has celebrated (baptism, confirmation and Holy Eucharist).
- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- There may be one or two. If you have two, one must be male, the other female.
- Must attend the events in the schedule indicated.
- Must be able to witness the catechumen's baptism/profession of faith on Easter Vigil. However, a proxy may stand in his/her place if need be.
- Must be ready to commit time to nurture the faith of the catechumen this year and in the years to come.
- Must be known by November 17.
