## Terry Fox Run

On **Thursday, September 19** students in Kindergarten to Grade Eight will be participating in the SAA Terry Fox Run. We are asking all students to bring in a donation of a loonie/toonie or \$5 for the Terry Fox Foundation, but any amount is welcome. Cheques need to be made out to the Terry Fox Foundation. Families can also donate online by clicking on the <u>SAA Terry Fox Link</u>. Students will be running shortly after 10:00 am. The students will be running a short circuit in the community. PM kindergarten students will run on their own during the afternoon.

We would like 10-12 volunteers, four will be needed at about 9:30 am to help prepare snacks and 5-6 to be at the school at about 9:50 am to help supervise kids on the running route. Be sure your child is dressed comfortably to run. Thanks for your help. After the run oranges will be served to students. We hope that students will wear their SAA gear or blue/green clothing.

## Order Hot Lunches Via School Cash

You may now go ahead and put in orders for special hot lunches, milk tags and lunch cards via <u>School Cash Online</u>. The next hot lunch day is Mr. Sub, on Thursday September 26th, deadline is on Sept. 18th.

There were some questions about snack shack & milk cards at school council the other night. The parents suggested including some more details in the bulletin along with pictures of the snack shack/milk ticket cards.

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The snack shack cards come in denominations of \$5 and \$10. Your child's name is on the card and your child can keep it in their lunch kit or keep it home for "special days". This allows your child to get an occasional item from the snack shack without having to send in any money to school. There are a variety of items ranging from 50 cents to \$2. (chips, jello cup, goldfish crackers package, veggies & dip in a cup, to pizza pop, nachos & salsa) Occasionally we have specials of the day that get announced the day prior (hot dogs, grilled cheese, pizza slices) so your child may let you know. We try to have a range of items but there may be limited quantities on any given day. The milk is delivered to the classrooms daily (unless we run out of milk near delivery dates) and the students hand in one pink milk coupon for a chocolate or white milk. If you would prefer your child to have white milk only please write this on the ticket. There are many life skills that are taught through the snack shack (waiting in line, using manners, patience and self-control (to not spend the whole card amount at once), many parents have allowed their child to have one card per report term and they use this to buy a treat occasionally.

The teachers were extremely helpful with the students learning how to use the snack shack cards and letting parents know if there would be a "special item" the next day.

# School Fees

#### Fieldtrip and Special Activity Fees

Last year our School Council indicated that parents would rather see pay as you go fees rather than term fees for Field Trips and Special Activities. This year we shall charge parents for Field Trips and special activities prior to the event and expect payment before the actual event.
