# <u>Annual North Central Teachers Convention - Feb. 6 & 7</u> IGNITE-INSPIRE-INNOVATE-INQUIRE


The North Central Teachers Convention is a two-day professional development conference held each February. Attendees include approximately 6,800 teachers. The convention provides Professional Development workshops, seminars and training over a two day period. It provides a great opportunity for teachers to collaborate, network, learn and share so that teachers can continue to grow in their practice and contribute ideas and opinions on relevant education issues. There is no school for students at SAA during these two days.

#### Jungle Book Fair!

Get ready to get wild at our Jungle Book Fair! The Scholastic book fair is returning to Sister Alphonse from **February 24-28** and this year's goal is to have \$1,800 worth of books purchased. The fair will be open during recess, with special after school sales on February 26 and 27 during Parent Teacher Interviews. In addition, everyone who purchases items from the fair can enter the door prize contest. One lucky student will win \$25 dollars' worth of books for themselves and their classroom! We will also be having our Classroom Wish List program, where families help enrich their child's classroom by purchasing books for their teacher's class library.

#### **Healthy Snacks Food Nutrition Grant**

The Government of Alberta continues to fund the Food Nutrition Grant Program for Alberta School Districts. At SAA all students have access to the snacks and we estimate approximately 50% of the student population access the food daily. In classrooms there are fruit baskets available all day, in addition snacks are available at the morning nutrition break, as well as those that may not come with lunch (or still hungry after eating their lunch) can ask for more to eat and we will get them





additional items. Snacks include fruit, vegetables, yogurt, granola and healthy drinks. In addition to the food we periodically provide informative slides and nutrition tips through the morning announcements, as well as informal discussions about healthy eating in the classrooms.
