2019/20 Final Report Cards

Report cards were sent electronically via email on the afternoon of Thursday, June 25. If you did not receive your child's Report card please call SAA before the end of the day on June 26. After June 26 call the District Office at 780-459-7711. Unfortunately, School Messenger was having some technical difficulties on Wednesday and Thursday. The issue appears to be resolved but some people did receive an error message when they tried to open the PDF report card. When they waited and tried again, it opened. It does not appear that this was a widespread problem; however, if you are having difficulty opening your child's report card, please try again as the problem is intermittent. Most parents that encountered the error, were able to open the report card after trying the link a second time.

2020/21 School Re-Entry Planning

Our District continues to make plans for the 20/21 school year. On Wednesday, June 10 Education Minister Adriana LaGrange outlined the 3 possible scenarios:

- 1. In School classes resume(near normal operations with health measures)++Targeted Scenario
- 2. In School Classes PARTIALLY resume (with additional health measures in addition to the above)
- 3. At Home learning continues (in school classes are cancelled)

The government has indicated that the preferred and likely scenario is that students will return to daily in-school classes at the beginning of the year. The government will share it's final decision by August 1 on which scenario will be in place at the beginning of the year. School Tools

A reminder about this year's "School Tools Program"! As your school year comes to a close the School Tools Program is just getting started. The site is now up although there are still some adjustments and fine tuning taking place by our programmers in the background. Once this is complete the site will have full speed and functionality. We sincerely appreciate everyone's patience



and understanding as this is completed. We wanted to provide you with a few updates and reminders prior to school ending that will be beneficial for parents as they begin to think about placing orders. Home delivery is now available at no extra cost to parents, orders will ship within 3 business days or sooner. Parents have the ability to remove or change any item from the online list that they do not require. There are no cut off dates for ordering, the site will remain up until mid September.

The pricing structure has changed. Pricing is based on the current Staples.ca pricing less the discounts. This means that the best time for parents to buy is after the first "Back to School" flyer is launched. Due to the Covid pandemic the first BTS flyer is now scheduled for launch on July 15th. Parents may want to consider ordering after this date as it will impact the price of their supplies.
