- 1. Solar for Schools Funding Program solar panels are placed on the school (we would need to write a letter of interest and gather quotes)
- 2. Developing more environmental initiatives at SAA (compost bins in classrooms)
- 3. Everactive Schools Program it is a non-profit initiative that works with the school to implement physical activity through a variety of means. They also support School Travel Planning encouraging active school travel (bike, walk, etc.) and work with AMA to develop a Safety Patrol Program
- -SAA will need parent champions that are interested in leading these initiatives alongside school staff
- -information will be added to the school newsletter and shared with staff
- -Concerns were brought forward regarding there not being crosswalks in front of the school and the speed of traffic through the traffic circle.
