Grade 2 and 3 Literacy!

Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools has partnered with University of Alberta's lead researcher and professor, Dr. George Georgiou, to participate in the Alberta Research Network (ARN) Literacy Study. The study aims to examine the learning loss in grade 2 and 3 students resulting from the pandemic and provides educators with professional learning opportunities on research-based practices to eliminate reading difficulties. Intervention work has started and we have three different staff members working with small groups of students.

Old Business from June 2021 meeting

Christine Hoskins attended the Alberta School Councils Association General Meeting in April. Possible initiatives that could be implemented as SAA include:

- 1. Solar for Schools Funding Program solar panels are placed on the school (we would need to write a letter of interest and gather quotes)
 - Steve Ducharme can help with this and is willing to be a point of contact
- 2. Developing more environmental initiatives at SAA (compost bins in classrooms)

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- 3. Everactive Schools Program it is a non-profit initiative that works with the school to implement physical activity through a variety of means. They also support School Travel Planning encouraging active school travel (bike, walk, etc.) and work with AMA to develop a Safety Patrol Program
