**Update:** The Alberta School Council Engagement Grant: Our division applied for this grant and they are working on allocating this to schools. Good news as this has resulted in each school being provided with \$500.00.

The GSACS Education Foundation website has posted applications for the <u>2021</u> <u>Group Grant Requests</u> from the Futures Fund - Deadline November 22, 2021. In 2020, the second year of distributing funds, the Foundation received seven applications and was pleased to support the following three school initiatives:

## SAA celebrated their first SAA Junior High Awards celebration during the afternoon of

**October 21, 2021.** Some of the awards presented included honour, honours with proficiency, the Recreation Academy award, Most Improved student awards, to name a few. Parents/Guardians of students receiving awards were invited to virtually participate in this exciting event. We are currently seeking sponsors for awards and we will be holding our awards ceremony in June of this year. Thank you to all of the parents/guardians who are partners in Catholic education at SAA!

**Staffing Update:** Recently we have been able to add areas of support to our school. As we have had an increase in enrolment we have been able to add a few more supports to SAA at this time:

**Kindergarten AM:** We welcome Ms. Jacqueline Wheeler, Educational Assistant to SAA! Ms. Wheeler comes to us with a lot of experience working with children in early childhood education and we know she will be a welcome addition to our Kindergarten classroom.

**Elementary level:** We welcome Educational Assistant, Ms. Dawn MacDonald to SAA on Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons!

Ms. MacDonald was already working at SAA on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, but now we have added her to the afternoons on these days as well! During this extra time Ms. MacDonald will be working with the Grade one and two students and teachers to provide additional support.

#### Junior High level:

We welcome Ms. Jamie-Lee Oliva to our junior high! Ms. Oliva currently is our Kindergarten AM teacher, but she also has experience in the option area, so we are happy to have her teach some of our junior high options this year.

Currently Ms. Oliva has been co-teaching with Ms. McKinnon the Fit For Life, but will now take over this class as part of her assignment. In addition to this block Ms. Oliva will be offering homework/core subject support for diverse learners in Junior High and will be teaching a block of Religion 9. These additional blocks are being added to the Tuesday/Thursday afternoon schedule. During semester 2 and 3, Ms. Oliva will be teaching options such as Art to our Junior High students. Mrs. Phillips will also be checking on the progress of our junior high students during this time as well.

Mr. Parks will also be teaching a block of Advanced Academic Preparation block and an additional Health block to our junior high students.

Thank you to all of our staff for demonstrating this flexibility in supporting the learning needs of our students.

**Literacy Grant support:** Due to a literacy grant we have received due to our work with literacy interventions and Dr. Georgiou at the University of Alberta, we have been able to increase Mrs. Teixeira's time goes further into the afternoon so she is able to do some small group support for a few blocks with teachers in Grades 1 - 3 classes.

#### **Collaborative Response - Learning teams!**

We are pleased to share that the staff are actively working on a new SAA Literacy Framework, which includes reading interventions.
