# Sister Alphonse - School Fees for 2022/2023 school year

\*This year we purchased a lot of textbooks out of our school based budget for our junior high students as they were using electronic resources, which is great; but other students requested having an actual book for a textbook.

#### School based fees:

2022/2023 school-based fees Review (Administrative Procedure 502). We will be reviewing the fees next month as this has to be completed prior to March 1, 2022.

\*Volleyball fee charged this year: \$105.00 \*Basketball fee charged this year: \$100.00

\*We will need to further explore the use of the School Agenda App with staff as right now it is not being used as much as it could be. Our hope is to expand the use of the student app and/or add the option of a coiled/paper agenda which assists students in being organized. Some staff see a need to use a school book agenda rather than the App. We will be discussing this further at our staff meeting on Friday.

\*\*Currently we do not charge fees for our options in the junior high such as Art, Foods, and Construction; but this needs to be examined as we are gaining in population and the cost of consumable supplies and equipment is increasing each year.

#### **COVID PROTOCOLS UPDATE:**

Good news! **Volunteers are once again being permitted at schools** - The double vaccination requirement has been removed: <u>AP 265 Volunteers in Schools</u> Currently cohorting is still in place so school assemblies are still not being permitted at this time.

- Deputy Minister Tremblay shared an updated <u>Guidance Document</u> from the Government of Alberta to reflect the new easing of restrictions.
- GSACRD is permitting spectators for school run extra curricular events in our schools.
   Spectators 13 years or older will be required to wear masks and physically distance in household groups.
- Our <u>GSACRD parent guidebook</u> was recently updated in February and was shared with parents in our weekly newsflash.
- Please note that there is a declaration volunteer form available that may be filled out
  if one would like to volunteer, but you have not received the child welfare check as of

<u>SAA Wish List Items</u> - We are hoping to also be able to invest again in our Music program. This year we purchased more Orph instruments so that there are enough now for all students to use one. It would be great to be able to purchase some Ukuleles as well. We are working towards being able to offer a more robust Music program at the junior high level as well.

**RISE** students typically have physical, cognitive, and/or diagnosed learning exceptionalities that interfere with their abilities to acquire age-appropriate academic, communication, and/or social skills.

- a) **Solar for Schools** Steve Ducharme shared some information with Christine regarding this initiative. In order to be able to move forward with this, our division would need to be in support/be involved. No update available as of yet.

All students receive hot lunch a few times during the year with the nutrition grant as well as receive daily/weekly snacks with the nutrition grant as well.
