IS YOUR BREATH HELPING

OR HURTING?

DIAPHRAGMATIC BREATHING

- Relaxed Shoulders
- Abdominal and Rib
 Expansion
- · Slow, Deep Breaths
- Rhythmic Movement
 - Soft Abdomen
- · Calm Emotional State

SHALLOW BREATHING • Shoulder Lifting • Chest Movement Dominates • Shallow, Quick Breaths • Tense Abdomen

- No Rib Expansion
- Feelings of Stress

Did you know that the simple act of breathing can profoundly impact your stress levels and overall well-being? When we feel overwhelmed, our breathing often becomes shallow and quick, which can trick our body into thinking there's danger, even when there isn't.

By taking slow, deep breaths, we activate the "calm down" part of our brain. This helps our heart rate slow down, our muscles relax, and our mind feel clearer. It's like giving your body and brain a quick reset button!

Take a look at the infographic from @andrea_evegenious. Repeat Diaphragmatic Breathing a few times, and notice how your body feels. Teaching our kids to take deep breaths when they're feeling anxious, frustrated, or overwhelmed can be a powerful tool for helping them manage big emotions.

Next time stress sneaks up, remember: just breathe. It's free, always available, and can make a world of difference!


