B. Healthy Hunger - Marianne Schiedel

- 1. June healthy hunger cheque received and deposited at end of June.
- 2. Set up Sept. to Dec.; All restaurants suggested on the June parent survey were looked into. Parent Survey Follow up:
 - a) Less than 50% wanted McDonald's no
 - b) Lots of suggestions for Healthy Restaurant Options, a few asking for Gluten Free Options
 - c) Tried to find 1 or more restaurants per month with Gluten Free
 - d) **Looking for Restaurants that are:** #1 available on Healthy Hunger; #2 In St. Albert / Able to Deliver to us; #3 Ease of Distribution (Do they organize by class & use student Labels); #4 Affordable; #5 Liked by many
 - e) All suggestions were researched. NOT AVAILABLE: A&W, Mr. Sub, Boardwalk, Arby's, Taco Time, Nello's, East Side Mario's, Jack's Burger Shack, Popeye's, Wendys (Booster Juice no meals / Nitza's significantly increased prices / Press'd Sandwich & Wok Box & Pizza 73 not organized by grade or class / Mucho Burrito no student labels), McDonald's 60 vote no
 - f) Chose: Boston Pizza, Dairy Queen, Edo, Subway, KFC, iHop, Pizza Hut, Chopped Leaf **BP & DQ are our biggest sellers**
- 3. Followed up with Mrs. Trenchard. She is still able and willing to help with Hot Lunches. Her grade 5 class will distribute lunches when the parents can not. We are hoping in the new year to have parents come 1/month on the 3rd Wednesday.
