



# 12 Ways to Build Resilient Learners



Practice coping strategies when calm





Teach and model flexible thinking skills





Learn and grow from failures together



Develop SMART goals and work on them



Reframe struggles as opportunities to grow

Teach and practice positive selftalk



Use confidencebuilding strategies



Check-in with emotions on a regular basis



Teach and encourage self-compassion



Encourage kids to solve problems on their own



Give puzzles, brainteasers, and challenges

When things feel hard, it's tempting to avoid them-but doing so only builds fear, not strength. Resilience means facing challenges even when they're uncomfortable. Each time we try, fail, learn, and try again, we grow more confident and capable. Avoidance may offer short-term relief, but resilience builds long-term strength. Let's remind students (and ourselves) that doing hard things is how we become braver, stronger, and more prepared for life.


